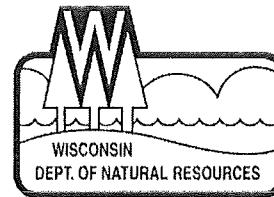

Dear Messrs. Poss and Orth:

On March 02, 2015, the Department received a letter jointly from the Lake Eau Claire Association (LECA) and Lake Eau Claire Protection and Rehabilitation District (LEPRD) requesting that the permittee be transferred from the LECA to the LECPRD for permits GP-WC-2011-18-06818 (half log structures), GP-WC-2011-18-06816 (tree drops) and IP-WC-2012-18-05603 (aerator system). Both the president of the LECA and the chairman of the LECPRD signed the letter in agreement upon this request.

In addition, the LECPRD and LECA requested that the fish habitat structure permits GP-WC-2011-18-06818 and -06816 be renewed.

Please accept this letter in response to your request. The Department hereby will grant a one-time extension to the fish habitat structure permits for an additional two years. The original permit conditions still apply. The permits will expire on March 09, 2017 and the project must be completed by that date, otherwise new permits will be required.

In addition, the Department acknowledges that the permittee is transferred from the LECA to the LECPRD for the above permits as of the date of this letter, for good cause. Amendments shall be processed under the name of the LECPRD.
