3. Treasurers report: Dean Boehne presented the financial report for Jan-June 2022. The report showed total revenue of \$183,909 and total expenditures of \$196,899. There is a cash balance of \$23,472.

9. Lake Management Plan Director Report

Rod gave an update on pending grants including:

Arpa grant from Eau Claire County for water testing equipment to be used on Lake Eau Claire and Lake Altoona.

Xcel grant for performing sediment coring on both lakes to determine sedimentation rates and composition.

Rod also explained two workshops held to provide training for the new bathymetric equipment and a demonstration of new water testing equipment we are hoping to buy if grant applications are successful.
